



Information Sheet for Janet & Leonard Storry Scholarship Fund



Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance towards the educational costs of gifted young persons under the age of 20 years. These educational costs may be of a short duration for a specific purpose or for longer periods of general education. Under the terms of the bequest (made in 1974), preference will be given to a young person whose present or future intention is to work within the mission of the Anglican Church in New Zealand or overseas. The fund is administered by the Trust Board of the Social Service Council of the Diocese of Christchurch, more commonly known as Anglican Care (Canterbury/Westland).

Criteria

Scholarships may be awarded by the trustees to applicants who can produce written evidence and independent references that:-

- They are under the age of 20 at the closing date of the application process.
- Demonstrate performance at an extremely high level of accomplishment in intellectual, creative, sporting or other activity compared to other persons of their age.

Note that preference will be given to applicants who are over the age of 15 at the closing date of the application process and who are committed to Christian work: and particular preference will be given to any applicant who genuinely plans to work as a Christian Missionary.

Consideration will also be given to the financial circumstances of each applicant.

Amounts

The number of scholarships awarded will be at the Trust Board's discretion and limited by the funds available and the suitability of the applicants. Longer periods of financial support will be considered by the Trust Board, subject to review and meeting specific performance measures.

Application process

Application for a scholarship needs to be made on the attached application form by any person either on behalf of young people who meet the above criteria or by the young persons themselves. The completed application form needs to be returned to:

and must be received **before 30 September** in any year in respect of scholarships to be awarded for use in the following calendar year. Applicants can expect to be given a decision within eight weeks of the closing date. The Trust Board reserves the right to choose to make payment to a third party on behalf of the applicant and not to award the whole sum available in any one or more year(s).

Successful applicants will be obliged to submit a written report to the Executive Officer within four weeks of completion of the educational purpose for which financial assistance was approved.
