

Remuneration for Youth Ministry Staff in Parishes / Ministry Units

Approved by the Standing Committee, ADMSC, up-dated @ 1 November 2020

NOTE: This scale is subject to percentage increases to stipends at 1 May annually, as approved by Standing Committee.

Pay Scale: The following hourly rates are recommended for Youth Ministry Staff in the ADMSC and reflect the following

- 1 The **priority** of Ministry to children and young people recognised in the Diocesan Strategic Plan *Growing Forward*
- 2 the importance of providing fair and reasonable remuneration to Youth Ministers and Lay Ministry staff
- 3 the employee's levels of qualifications and experience, and the responsibilities of the particular role.

Parishes / Ministry Units are encouraged to support wherever possible:

- 4 the sustainability and retention of lay youth ministry staff, including allowing for Study Leave (recommended 1 month each 3 years)
- 5 time and funding for Professional Development including education towards diploma or degree level Ministry and / or Theological qualifications.

Steps	Description of Qualifications and Experience	Hourly Rate
Step 1	Has a limited experience of youth ministry / youth work	\$22.10
Step 2	Holds a Certificate -level qualification in ministry, theology, youth work, teaching or other relevant equivalent qualification and some relevant experience	\$22.42
Step 3	Holds a Diploma -level qualification in ministry, theology, youth work, teaching or other relevant equivalent qualification and has three years relevant experience	\$24.13
Step 4	Holds a Degree -level qualification in ministry, theology, youth work, teaching or other relevant equivalent qualification and has three years relevant experience	\$26.12
Step 5	In addition to the qualifications and experience of Step 4, holds a position of senior responsibility eg has oversight of 10 or more staff/trainees and/or volunteers or a youth group of over 50 members. NB : This step applies as a minimum level for all Diocesan Youth Ministry appointments.	\$28.74
