




CPT Income 2019: \$1.797m

Estates & Trusts 2019

- Bishopric Estate. \$197k surplus, \$3.79m net assets
- Dean & Chapter Estate. \$106k surplus, \$1.4m net assets
- General Trust Estate. \$824k surplus, \$13.7m net assets.
- CPT holds \$274m net assets in trust relating to Land & Buildings (including the 'Cathedral Trust')




Funds Under Management 2019:

- \$112m in FUM, plus Term Deposits of \$39M:
 - Balanced Growth Fund, \$27m
 - Fixed Income Fund & Reserve Fund, \$43m
 - Insurance Proceeds Fund, \$39m

 Maintenance & Insurance Fund, \$43m & \$435k



Balanced Growth Fund


Total Assets \$27.6m as at 31st December 2019

- Income Earned \$2.9m



Earthquake Recovery Programme:

- ▶ The Earthquake Recovery Programme will be complete in 2021.
- ► This has involved 243 separate projects 123 Churches, 50 Halls/parish buildings & 50 vicarages.
- Many complex repairs to heritage buildings and several new builds.
- Working with EQC for residential projects.
- Interpretation of obligations as 'insurer'.
- Complex issues around GST treatment.
- Excluding the Cathedral & including parish betterment undertaken with EQ repairs – close to \$100 million project.
- CPT would like to thanks all of the parishes involved for their input and encouragement since the earthquakes – this has been a collective effort.
